### **Getting Started:**

1 Download the App

Download free 'iMagic track' App from App store or Goolge play.



# 2 Register / Login Register the account and login.

#### 3 Pair Mini

Pull out the insulating paper, follow the in-app instructions to active Mini.

- \* Enable phone Bluetooth and location services before pairing.
- \* Up to 12 trackers can be paired with an iPhone. 4-6 trackers can be paired with an Android phone.

## 4 Attach tracker to your items

The tracker can be attached to your keychain, bag or other items.

If the strap is required, follow the guidance below to install the strap.

#### 5 Keep App active in background In order to make the tracker work properly, please keep 'iMagic track'App active in the background. For more details, please read the 'Anti-lost Permissions setting' in the instructions for the App.

# Functions:



Press the 'call' button within App to call your Mini when it is connected to your phone.

Bi-directional Alarm

Both the tracker and your phone will alarm when they disconnect.

Find-it Mode

Set the tracker to 'find-it mode' to disable all the anti-loss alarms.



The App will automatically record the 'disconnected location', this is the location where tracker was disconnected from your phone.

#### Smart Silence



There are two 'silent modes' in the App: Set your home and work place as silent regions. Set bed time as a silent period.
